

Instruction Manual - BluTrack


1. Create a new user

To create a user You need to enter http://blutrack.eu/register, fill in all the fields, and push the Submit button.



After creating a new account, you will be redirected to the **Settings** page, where you need to enter the login and password that were previously created in BluConsole. Please fill in all the fields (Login BluConsole, Password BluConsole and Password confirm BluConsole) and click on the **Save** button.





2. LOGIN TO BLUTRACK


If You have already an account on BluTrack You can simply go on http://blutrack.eu/login to log into the system, just fill in the **Email** and **Password** fields and click on the **Login** button.





3. Import devices from BluConsole to BluTrack

After setting BluConsole account data in the BluTrack **Settings** page, (which was described in the previous part), you can import all your devices. To import devices, click on the dropdown **Devices** menu from the top menu and choose **Download devices**. Once the download is completed, you will redirected to **Your devices** page and see a message in the top part of the page with a list of all devices below.






3. Data on your devices page

In 10 columns we see the following data:

- Number
- Device number device ID
- Name name of the device from bluConsole or after update from BluTrack
- Temperature limits from bluConsole or after update from BluTrack
- Temperature last measured temperature
- Last place name of the last place where the logger was detected
- Geo latitude and longitude of the last place
- Status device status
- Organization organization the logger belongs to
- Actions
 - o history 24h history of position tle logger
 - o view information about device and basic settings that can be altered in bluTrack


BluTrack will collect the information from bluConsole only if the **Status** of the device is set to **In use**. This can be done after clicking on the **View** button and then on tab called **Edit settings**.





4. HISTORICAL DATA

To access the historical data regarding the movement of all the devices within the hubs' range, you need to click on the **History** button on **Your devices** page. If a hub is already in the bluTrack database, the information such as the hub's place name, description and position will be displayed. If the hub is new the place name label will be set by default as "HUB: XXXXXXXX" where XXXXXXXXX is the ID of the hub. The default position of unrelated hubs is set on 0,0 with empty description.






5. Adding hub information to BluTrack

For now this operation can be done only by one of the BluTrack's administrators under link http://blutrack.eu/hubs. If You want to add a localization, You should send to us the following data:

- place name
- place description
- your hub ID
- geolocalization points





6. Transports

Transport is an additional functionality of bluTrack. It helps organize small transports. Each BluTrack user has his own transport list. To add a new transport, you need to go to **Transports** and then choose the option **Add transport**.
